

Open Letter from the President

Dr. Juan Andrade

We're back! And we're especially glad you're here. It's been three years since our last in-person conference in February 2020. Two "virtual" national conferences offered powerful programs but lacked the elements of that made this conference different from all the rest – the excitement, constant networking, the high energy, the electricity that filled the air when we packed the ballrooms twice a day. Now, February 2023, we're going to "build back better!"

Our first national conference was in November 1983. We expected 300 participants and 674 showed up! We knew we were on to something big. By 1987 the word was out and the first presidential candidates came to address the conference and our attendance grew. The next president of the U.S. came in 1991, blew off the roof, and our conference was on its way to national prominence! For 27 years, from 1993-2020, the USHLI conference annually attracted over 5,000-6,000 participants, mostly college students and young professionals from 40 states, and remained the premier conference of choice for an entire generation of leaders. An estimated 150,000 emerging young leaders and activists made life-changing decisions and found life-long relationships at our national conference and are in leadership positions today throughout the country.

COVID-19 derailed much of what we had achieved for nearly 40 years, but a revival of what the USHLI conference was before COVID is at hand today. We're counting on you to help us rebuild and restore the spirit, energy, and power of the greatest national conference for young leaders in the nation! Thank you.
